Hunting season is over unless you hunt geese and it will be another month before spring turkey season so I thought I'd talk a little about shed hunting, personally I haven't had much luck finding them but other people I've talked to have found some. It is nice to know that the monster buck that eluded you just out of range or you spooked as you were getting to your stand had survived the winter and that you may get another chance at him next fall. Good places to look are at known fence crossings and at ditches where the impact of jumping over a fence or down into a ditch will jar them loose. It is also very helpful to see all the well beaten down deer trails going through the woods as the deer will use these trails all year long and may give you some ideas on where to hang some stands for next year.

Indoor target season is going strong right now and several club members made the trek to Las Vegas to the World Archery Festival. No world champs from our club but they tell me they had a great time. There a quite a few archers from eastern NE and western IA that make it a yearly trip.

Indoor 3d was held in Columbus in January and a bunch of us went over and shot that, It's a blast to see 34 people all standing on the shooting line and flinging arrows left, right, near and far.. They usually get 400-600 people at this shoot .Another one is scheduled for Wahoo next month.

Leagues are going Monday and Wednesday nights at 7:00 pm Fita targets on Monday, animal targets on Wednesday. We always welcome more people to shoot league for the whole season or just for a night or two.
