June 30, 2009 Meeting Minutes  
7:00 P.M.

- Meeting was called to order at 7:06 P.M. at Moeller Field

- Secretaries Report: Dave Strong did not bring a copy of last month's meeting minutes with him so no minutes were read.
- Treasurers Report:
  - The Treasurer's report was approved as written
  - Our rent has been paid for the next 3 months.
  - Reported that we had 106 people shoot at the last 3D and that with the League and 3D deposit \$1,566.22 was deposited.
  - Club recognized Gene Metschke and his hard work as 3D Chairman. Gene expressed his appreciation to all the members who helped and reminded us all that much help will be need for the J.C. Fremont 3D Tournament as it is another 2-day shoot.
  - Some discussion took place regarding the use of some of the money that we have in the Fremont Community Foundation for purchase of some needed equipment for the club. Tabled this discussion to a later time.
- Old and New Business:
  - Youth Park & Recs Summer League-Dave Strong reported that Vince and he have 6 youngsters shooting on Thursday evenings. It is going quite well and there is 3 weeks left to go. Dave was not sure if there would be another summer league scheduled at the conclusion of this one.
  - Parks & Recs Playground Program Archery Day-Dave Strong reported that next Wednesday July 8<sup>th</sup> was the day that the Parks & Recs scheduled to have children brought to Monnich Park to shoot Archery. The times are 9:30 A.M. to 11:45 A.M. and 1:15 P.M. to 3:30 P.M. Chris Johannesen, Donna Anderson, Dave Kerschinske, and Dave Strong will try to be available to teach the youth that day.
  - Summer ELL School Archery Day-Dave Strong reported that the teacher in charge of the summer school program at Washington will be in touch with him to set a morning to teach Archery to the ELL students again this summer.
  - In Door Range Report—Bob Betkie reports that it is “too hot” to go up there!

--Out Door Range Report—Frank Hasek reports that weed eating is done and that the 1<sup>st</sup> Summer League will end this Wednesday July 1<sup>st</sup>. A second Out Door League will begin on Wednesday July 15<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 P.M. and will run for 8 weeks every Wednesday through September 2<sup>nd</sup>. This will give the club an opportunity to pick up the targets on Wednesday September 9<sup>th</sup>.

- ✓ Kevin Hernes brought up some concerns mentioned to him by 3D participants who are Hunter Ed Instructors. The concern was that at the last shoot several targets were set on top of a hill and silhouetted to where one had to shoot over the hill if missing the target. Concern was that this was not a safe shot and not one any responsible hunter should take. Gene noted the concern and will work to not have this happen again in the future. Had to for this meet due to the rain and mud and not being able to set targets apart like on a normal situation.

--3D Grounds land help—The Club discussed donating some time and money to help fix the road and culverts out at the Camp to make it better accessible for 3D participants. Camp Calvin Crest would pay at least \$400 of the cost and the RHA Club would pay around \$500. The members voted to pursue this and Brad, Frank, and Gene will get started contacting a contractor (Kevin Indra) who will do the work.
