MEETING MINUTES

President Chris Johannesen called the meeting to order at 7:02 P.M.

Secretaries Report:

- President Chris asked for any corrections on the minutes from the May 27th meeting. A motion was made to accept and to approve the May meeting minutes and newsletter as printed (see web sight for minutes). Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: Club members approved the Treasurer's report given by Dave Kerschinske.

- Our NFFA dues are due soon (we need 5 members from our club to satisfy the requirements)
- The June 8th RHA 3D tournament attendance was down with only 23 shooters. It was mentioned that the muddy and rainy day was the cause of poor attendance. Club members have said that the word on the street is that our new location is really a good one and that weather permitting folks will be turning out for the July 12-13th John C. Fremont RHA 3D shoot.

Committees' & Managers' Reports:

- Indoor Range Report: Bob Betke reported:
 - ✓ Club still needs to get rid of the pop machine
- Youth Archery Instructional Programs:
 - ✓ *Park & Recs Youth Outdoor League/Instructional program* at Monnich Park is going well with 8-10 students shooting. Thanks to Vince Smith and Dave Strong for running this program.
 - ✓ On Wednesday July 16th from 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM the RHA Club will be doing an *Archery awareness/shooting experience for the Park & Recs summer neighborhood parks day care program*. All day long the Parks and Rec will bus different groups of children to Monnich Park for an outdoor archery experience. If any club member can help this day we could sure use the help even if you can only work a portion of the day. Chris Johannesen, Donna Anderson, and Dave Strong are planning to be there the whole day so any additional help even if for only part of the day will be appreciated.
- Adult Leagues Reports:
 - ✓ *Outdoor League:* Club members may shoot Sunday noon through Thursday night at the outdoor range at Camp Eagle. Don't forget: All day Friday, all day Saturday, and Sunday mornings until noon you can't shoot at Camp Eagle.
 - ✓ *The 1st summer League* results with one more week to go were presented by President Chris. The last night will be range finder night (shooters will be allowed to use their range finders to check yardage for this last night.) Chris says that usually folks shoot a lower score when allowed to use their range finders.
 - ✓ July 9th we will begin the *2nd summer league* at the Outdoor Range at Camp Eagle. The cost for club members will be \$28.00. It will run for 8 weeks in order to be completed by the Labor Day weekend.

Old Business:

- The new target bales are set up at Monnich Park and are very nice. Also, a big load of sand was delivered to the broad-head pit. A big thanks to Ed and Lee Altmanshofer for their hard work to construct the special frames to lock the targets as well as their installation. Lee asked about putting one more target up at 50 yards to complete the range. The Club voted to purchase one more target after the John C. Fremont 3D Tournament when more money might be available. Motion carried with Vince Smith voting an absentee NO vote for Garland Stewart.

New Business:

- RHA 3D Tournament held during the Fremont's J. C. Fremont Days on July 12th-13th at Camp Calvin Crest.

- Secretary's Side Note: Please consider helping in anyway that you are able to for this b-i-g event. This is one of our only large money-makers and if we want to keep our dues low and to be able to afford to keep our club running well and able to serve the community we need to make this event successful. **Call Gene Metschke @289-3487 to volunteer your help in anyway that you can.**

- Club member participation is much needed for this 2-day Tournament. ALL club members should try to please help in some way if possible.....Areas to consider helping are:
 - Weed eating lanes and setting stakes for targets at the camp—Call Gene to find out when he is going out to work on this project the week of the tournament.
 - Friday (July 11th) at 6:00 PM meet at the storage unit to load targets and to set them up at Camp Calvin Crest.
 - Registration—On both days (July 12-13th) we need help at the registration table.
 - Special Games Shooting events—On both days (July 12-13th) we have a "ping-pong ball shoot" and a "long range shot" and we need people to help man these 2-stations and to encourage shooters to try the games before or after they are done shooting the course.
 - Concession workers—we will be selling concessions (sloppy joes, chips, and pop, plus sliced watermelon) and we can use volunteers to man this station. **DONATE A WATERMELON!**
 - Take down and hauling the 3D targets out and back to the storage unit at the end of the Tournament on Sunday July 13th probably around 2:30 PM.
 - *Other areas you might consider to donate and to help with:*
 - Anyone who cares to donate prizes for the "ping-pong ball shoot" may do so to help defray costs, etc.
 - Club members are asked to donate water melons to be used at the concession sales.
 - Sue Strong will donate paper plates and utensils to cut down on costs. Dave Strong will take care of working with Lou's and Nebraska Sports to get prizes from them. Donna Anderson and Chris Johannesen will take care of "sloppy-joe fixins". Brad Johannesen will contact Full Draw Archery for donations.
- The RHA Club voted "yes" to allow Mr. Bryce Lambley to have a booth and to sell his newly authored book that he has written and asked that he donate a book to our prizes for the day.
