

# **Robinhood Archery Club**

## **Minutes of Meeting**

### **March 31, 2009**

President Dave Kerschinske called the meeting to order at 7:05pm. Members present were Kevin Hernes, Gene Metschke, Dylan Flanagan, Jerry Bennett, Ed Altmanshofer, Luke Grenier, Brad & Chris Johannesen, Donna Anderson, Frank Hasek, Garland Stewart, Bob Betkie, and Vince Smith.

Minutes from the February meeting were approved as written. The Treasurer's report was approved as presented.

Bob Betkie reported that JOAD is the only remaining indoor league. Fun night will be April 17<sup>th</sup>. Frank Hasek reported he has talked with Tom Lee at Camp Eagle and he will clean up some downed trees on the road if we give him a week's notice before outdoor league starts. Set up for outdoor league will be April 22<sup>nd</sup> and league will begin on April 29<sup>th</sup>.

Gene Metschke reported on the upcoming 3-D tournament at Camp Calvin Crest on April 19<sup>th</sup>. He will be calling for help and hopes to install a bridge before the June tournament so there can be two half-courses. A port-a-potty may be needed if the Camp is unable to turn on the water to the restrooms before the April shoot. Danny Tubbs from Lincoln called Gene and is interested in having 3 or 4 clubs go together and put on a Rinehart R100 tournament. Gene will get more details.

The Board of Directors at Camp Calvin Crest approved construction of a storage shed for our 3-D targets, etc. An agreement was signed by the Director and President Kerschinske which allows for its use by Robinhood for at least ten years, barring any unforeseen circumstances. Josh DePatie of Moose Carpentry will begin construction as soon as possible.

The 3-D targets were inventoried, four are missing but there is an extra standing bear. Two deer were missing cores and could be part of the four missing targets. These deer and four turkeys were scrapped as unusable. A motion was made and approved to purchase two new Rinehart targets: a spike buck and a fallow deer for \$524 plus shipping & handling. Brad will order these.

Results of the two indoor leagues will be unavailable for a couple weeks while a few people make up missing scores.

Prices on pop and candy at the range and for tournaments were discussed. It was agreed to start charging \$1.00 for pop at the 3-D's. Gene will pick up pop and candy at Costco which will help provide the club with some profit from concessions.

Vince announced the summer parks and recreation children's league will be May 21<sup>st</sup> at 6:30pm at Monnich park. The target butts need replacing beforehand and a new supply of arrows is needed. Dave will contact the Parks & recreation about cost-sharing these items. Brad will get price estimates.

Chris reported she has begun work on the IRS filing of the 501c3 tax exempt forms. A Federal Employer's Identification number will be needed and the cost of the filing will be \$750. A motion was made and approved to proceed and complete the filing of these forms.

There was no other business and the meeting adjourned at 7:55.
