- Outdoor Range Report: President Kerschinske reported that it is going well. Brad pointed out that a couple of the younger guys shooting the League are really enjoying it very much.
- Indoor Range Report:

- Youth Archery Instructional Programs:
 - ✓ Park & Recs Thursday night Summer Outdoor Kid's League will begin the first Thursday in June (which is June 5th) at 6:30 P.M. at Monnich Park. It will run for 6-weeks and Vince Smith is in charge of it and Dave Strong will assist him. Any help from club members will be greatly appreciated.
 - ✓ The Summer Parks/Playground program where they bring kid's to Monnich Park to get to shoot Archery will be held on Wednesday July 8th with two sessions. Chris Johannesen and Dave Strong will work with this project. Any club member available to help this day is very welcome! Times for each session are: 9:30-11:45 A.M. and 1:15-3:30 P.M.
- 3-D Tournament (June 13-14th): Gene Metschke reported on plans for the June 3-D Tournament
 - ✓ It will be a two-day Tournament. Gene reported that the purpose is to try to get more shooters to shoot our tournament because many shooters have expressed an interest to shoot on Saturday as they have to work on Sundays. Please note the following dates and times to be available to help Gene:
 - Saturday May 30th at 9:00 A.M.—meet at storage unit to haul targets to new shed at Camp Calvin Crest.
 - Friday June 12th at 6:00 P.M.—meet at the shed at Camp Calvin Crest to set up the targets for the 3-D.
 - Saturday June 13th-14th—is the weekend 3-D Shoot. Help is needed so come and shoot and then help.
- Newly discussed N-100 3-D Tournament:
 - ✓ Gene M. and Dave K. talked about a proposed Nebraska 100-target 3-D shoot that could be hosted by the four area clubs (RHA, Prairie Bowmen, Ahamo, and Golden Arrow). This was discussed as a possibility to replace a R-100 3-D Tournament that may not be able to materialize. Robin Hood Archery Club would be the host club as it would take place at Camp Calvin Crest in September of 2010 (a year from this Fall). A lot of discussion must take place first to insure that each club does their share of the workload and that RHA would not end up doing the lion's share of the work. The Club voted to continue to pursue and discuss this with the other 3 clubs at their next meeting in Omaha at the UpStream Restaurant. The Club also voted to pay for the club's representatives' meal.
- Target butts and arrows from the Parks & Recs:
 - ✓ President Dave reported that he was still waiting for a call back from Kim Koski at the Park & Recs concerning the status on the target butts and the arrows. There is a need to get new target butts installed at Monnich Park and also a need to get more arrows for the kid's leagues, etc. We will keep checking.
- 501C3 Update:
 - ✓ Chris reported on the status of her application for the club to get a 501C3. It is progressing well and we should have it.
- Meeting adjourned at 8:10 PM. Next meeting will be Tuesday June 30th @7PM at the Moeller Field building.
