Minutes of Meeting

October 27, 2009

Call to Order: Dave Kerschinske called the meeting to order at 7:10pm with 16 members present.

Minutes: Minutes of the September 29th meeting were approved.

Treasurer's Report: Kevin Hernes presented the Treasurer's report, which showed \$1,734.86 in checking, \$457.11 in savings, and \$6,283.83 in a CD. Funds are also still deposited with the Friends of Fremont. The NFAA charter was sent in. The State NSAA has still not cashed our check from the State marked 3-D; Chris Johannesen will contact the state secretary. Kevin Hernes will donate a file cabinet to the club to keep all paperwork in a central location.

501c3 Application: Chris has completed this paperwork. A check for \$750 was written to send to the IRS with the application.

Indoor Range: The range is clean, thanks to Bob Betkie, and the target butts should be OK for tournaments as they still stop arrows, although the fronts are loose and don't hold targets well.

Outdoor Range: Not currently in use.

Parks & Rec Children's league: Nine children and one adult are participating. Jerry Bennett will help Frank this Thursday while Vince is out of town.

Camp Calvin Crest bridge/course work: Brad has located telephone poles at a cost of \$1/foot but we need a 20' trailer to haul them from southern Nebraska. Jerry Bennett will try to find one. Tournament dates for 2010 are April 11, May 2, June 13, and September 11-12th. Due to a Reinhardt R100 tournament at Branched Oak on July 10-11, 2010, we will not hold a 3D during John C. Fremont Days. The members voted to add another 3D on August 15th to make up for the JCF Days tournament and Dave Kerschinske will contact Sonny Fiala with the additional date for the master schedule. Chris Johannesen will contact Craig @ Calvin Crest.

R100 July 10-11, 2010: Four to five members will need to help from each club to put on this tournament. Check your schedules and contact Dave Kerschinske if you can be there.

Nebraska 100 Sept. 11-12, 2010: This will be held at our range at Calvin Crest. Each club will bring and set up 25 targets. Registration and concessions will be shared between the four clubs.

Annual Banquet: Members voted to hold the annual banquet again in January. No date was set.

Membership/Key exchange: Thirty-one members have paid their dues so far.

Indoor Tournament dates: Five dates were chosen for indoor tournaments and Dave Kerschinske will attend the President/Secretary's meeting to arrange dates with all the clubs. Chris will email state president Matt Carmin with our requested dates.
