Meeting Minutes for Sept. 30, 2008

President Chris Johannesen called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. Members present were Ed Altmanshofer, Lee Altmanshofer, Bob Betkie, Frank Hasek, Kevin Hernes, Brad Johannesen, Dave Kerschinske, Vince Smith, and Garland Stewart.

Minutes of the August meeting were approved as printed. Dave Kerschinske presented the Treasurer's report. The CD comes due in October. A motion was made to withdraw \$2500 from the CD and hold it in checking for purchasing materials for a storage shed to be built at Camp Calvin Crest. The motion passed 8 to 1. Chris will find out how much is currently in the Friends of Fremont account and how to access that money if needed.

A crew of 9 volunteers cleaned the Indoor Range, glued targets for leagues, and repaired the children's bows by putting on sites, nocks, etc. New strings and cables are needed for the 5 Genesis bows and a motion was made, seconded and approved to order those. The non-working pop machine was removed by a gentleman who hauled it away for free.

The Children's Parks & Rec program will start Thursday, October 2nd and run through November 13th. An ad has already been placed in the Tribune. JOAD began last Friday, September 26th with nine boys participating.

The Outdoor Range has been dismantled and targets are stored at Monnich Park. The September 7th Tournament had 77 shooters and since pop and trophies did not have to be purchased, most of the registration money was profit.

Construction of a storage unit at Camp Calvin Crest was discussed. The next step is to present a request and proposed plan of the shed to the Board of Directors at the Camp. Several members will get estimates on a 12x20 or 14x20 size shed for consideration at the next meeting. The wood shed is to have a cement floor, no windows, and a single garage door.

Winners of the second Outdoor League were Gene Metschke - 1st place and Brad Johannesen - 2nd place. Checks were issued for the winners.

New Business:

Adult leagues begin soon. The 300 target round starts Monday, Oct. 6th, at 7:00pm. Animal league begins Wed., Oct 8th, at 7:00pm. Cost will remain the same: \$35/ten weeks for members and \$45/ten weeks for non-members.

Membership Renewals will take place in October and the key to the front door will change at the next meeting, October 28th.

The new Morrell targets at Monnich Park have seen considerable use and are shot through in the center. New bags to cover the targets cost \$17 each. It was decided to wait until next spring to consider purchasing new targets.

No other business being presented the meeting was adjourned at 7:49 pm.
