

Robinhood Archery Club Meeting

March 29, 2011

7:00 P.M.

- The meeting was called to order at 7:04 P.M. by President Dave K. with 11 members present (Gene M., Chris J., Brad J., Craig G., Bob B., Jerry B., Dave K., Frank H., Kevin H., Sue S., and Dave S.).
- The minutes of the February RHA Club were reviewed and approved (moved by Gene M. and seconded by Chris J.).

Treasurer's Report: (Sue Strong gave her report—see attached hand-out report)

- Chris J. reported that we need to send a check for the amount of \$679.00 to the NSAA in care of Deb Colgrove for the past State Tournament that RHA hosted at our indoor range. It was a good turnout and shoot.
- Chris J. also reported that she took care of sending the correct forms to the IRS in reference to our non-profit status.
- Discussion took place concerning the purchase of 3D target cores for the Outdoor League targets that we will be putting up at Camp Eagle for the summer leagues. It was moved by Dave S. and seconded by Chris J. to authorize Brad J. with Frank's help to purchase the needed cores from Full Draw Archery as soon as possible. Range of cost is up to \$500.00.
- Sue S. will pay out to the winners of the Winter Leagues the money for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places.
- Brad J. moved and Gene M. seconded that we approve the Treasurer's Report as made. Motion carried.

- Thursday Night Parks & Recs Kid's League—Dave S. reported that it went very well and that the Fun Night was great for the kids. Attendance was up with around 15 kids participating.
- Friday Night JOAD League—Brad and Chris reported that it too is going well with 2 weeks more to go. Attendance was also up with around 20 youth participating.
- State Indoor Tournament—was a huge success with a very good turnout of shooters on both Saturday and Sunday. Sue and Chris will take care of making sure that the State Association (NSAA) gets paid the money owed to them.

- Discussion took place concerning safety issues with Midland University using our Indoor Range. Our Indoor Range Manager Bob B. has observed the class using

our range and equipment and mentioned a couple of concerns with safety and the use of our equipment. Chris J. will make some contacts with Midland University's Athletic Director and we will work on straightening out any issues so that our liability and safety are maintained.

Outdoor Range (Monich Park and Camp Eagle)

- Jerry B. was present with a proposal to take a look at a joint venture with the City Parks & Recs, the Isaac Walton, and our Robinhood Archery Club to try to hold our summer kid's archery programs out at the Ike's new outdoor range. It is a very nice facility and also would have restrooms available for the kids and adults to use. The Club discussed at length some issues to work out such as storage, etc. and directed Jerry to explore the possibilities with the Isaac Walton and Fremont Parks Boards and then to report back to us at a later time.
- Frank H. reported that it is getting time to have a work party to get the targets set at Camp Eagle for the Outdoor Leagues and summer usage.
- Frank reported that the Scouts have not yet got the target stakes made that they were to have replaced from the problem last summer. Dave K. will check into this.
- April 20th at 6:30 P.M. will be the evening to plan to help set up the course at Camp Eagle. Anyone who can help is asked to meet at Monnich Park at 6:30 P.M. where we will load targets into pick-ups and drive to Camp Eagle to set them up. If we can get plenty of help, it should only take about one hour or so, so p-l-e-a-s-e consider turning out to help! The OUTDOOR LEAGUE will begin on April 27th!
- **Reminder: Any RHA Club member can go out to Camp Eagle to shoot the 3D course—but please adhere to the following rules of the Boy Scout Camp:**
 - Sign-in at Tom Lee's home (there is a sign in notebook by his front door and sign in each time you shoot.) --Members only can shoot.
 - You may shoot only during the weekdays from Monday through Friday...you must not shoot at Camp Eagle from Friday at 12:00 Noon through Sunday until after 1:00 P.M.

Camp Calvin Crest 3D Tournament Report: (Gene M.)

- May 1st is the first 3D meet of our season. Gene M. will begin to figure out what he needs for help and we will begin recruiting able bodied souls to help get things ready.

N100 3D Tournament Report: (Dave K. reported)

- Dave K. reported that he received a letter from Danny Tubbs about the N100 to have an organizational meeting sometime the week of Memorial weekend. The Tournament is scheduled for Father's Day weekend in June (18th & 19th).

- Dave K. voiced some concerns about that weekend and he will report back after he visits with all of the other archery clubs involved in putting this meet on.

Other Items of Business:

- Jerry B. reported on an old RHA Club ledger/journal that Joan Strimple has given back to the club. She kept newspaper clips and notes of RHA news dating back to probably the 1950's. Jerry is in the process of getting a copy transcript of this notebook made for the club to archive. What a neat treasure to get.

Motion made by Jerry B. and seconded by Frank H. to adjourn the meeting at 9:00 P.M.
