I have one of the seven bucks and there is plenty of room in the freezer for more and you can rest assured I'll be out there again this week. I plan on keeping my tally sheet going until the season ends so if you get a deer I will add it to my sheet if you let me know. Everyone listed on my sheet is being kept in confidence between just me and you because I've been told by some that they don't want a lot of publicity about their kill numbers and I respect their wishes.
