In last month's letter I said I would report on how many deer I know about that have been shot this year. So far I only know of 3 does taken by our club members. I attended a meeting to set the 3d tournaments for 2010 and found out that the Rinehart R-100 that Prairie Bowmen, Ahamo, Golden Arrow and Robinhood jointly applied for was approved and is going to happen July 11-12, 2010 at Branched Oak Lake. More details will follow. The 4 clubs are also going to put on the Nebraska 100 which will be a 2 day 50 targets per day tournament and that is going to be held at our range at Camp Calvin Crest.
