

Robinhood Archery Club Meeting

April 26, 2011

- The meeting was called to order at 7:05 P.M. by President Dave K. with 11 members present (Gene M., Chris J., Brad J., Bob B., Dave K., Frank H., Kevin H., Sue S., Dave S., Ed A., and Steve H.).
- The minutes of the March RHA Club were reviewed and approved (moved by Bob B., and seconded by Gene M.).

Treasurer's Report: (Sue Strong gave her report—Chris J. moved to approve and Gene M. seconded.)

Indoor Range Report: (Bob B.)

- Chris reported on talking with Midland about the usage of the Indoor Range. Midland A.D. will take care of the problem. The RHA Club will review existing Indoor Range Usage guidelines by outside groups and will present the updated copy to Midland before next Fall.
- Thursday Night Parks & Recs Kid's League—Dave S. reported that it went very well and that the Fun Night was great for the kids. Attendance was up with around 15 kids participating.
- Friday Night JOAD League—Brad and Chris reported that it too is going well with 2 weeks more to go. Attendance was also up with around 20 youth participating.
- State Indoor Tournament—was a huge success with a very good turnout of shooters on both Saturday and Sunday. Sue and Chris will take care of making sure that the State Association (NSAA) gets paid the money owed to them.

- Discussion took place concerning safety issues with Midland University using our Indoor Range. Our Indoor Range Manager Bob B. has observed the class using our range and equipment and mentioned a couple of concerns with safety and the use of our equipment. Chris J. will make some contacts with Midland University's Athletic Director and we will work on straightening out any issues so that our liability and safety are maintained.

Outdoor Range (Monich Park and Camp Eagle)

- The Outdoor Range at Camp Eagle is a mud-hole. We will try to set up on May 3rd (weather permitting).
- Camp Calvin Crest 3D Course—Gene reported on needs and what work that needs to be completed before the next Tournament. He wanted to know who had the 3 missing targets? He asked Dave Strong if he had them yet from the Bow Hunter Ed Class taught last August. Dave reported that he had no keys to enter the storage shed and also that Gene himself had come at the end of the outdoor class on that Saturday last August and took all of the targets back himself to the storage garage.
Please note that Gene later did find the missing targets in the storage

shed. It was mentioned that Bob Koska from the Camp is doing ok now. The shelter has new picnic tables and the bridge is still there. We can build a bridge on the south side for future 3D Tournaments. Brad made a motion to purchase 3 more bag targets for Monich and stated that he will check with the City.

- Parks & Rec. Summer Archery Class—Dave K. reported that the use of the Ike's new range passed. A meeting with Jerry B. will be needed to get 2 keys and to talk about the specifics of using the Range.
- N100 meeting—Dave K. reported that he will attend a meeting in Wahoo to discuss the plan for this Tournament to be held on June 18-19th.
