

Robin Hood Archery Club Meeting Minutes

- Club decided not to have a Wednesday Night Animal League because no one expressed an interest due to the hunting season. President Kerschinske said that we will try to run an Animal League in January after the archery deer season is over.

- **Blackburn Storage**—Dave Kerschinske reported that he took care of closing the account for the storage unit that we no longer need due to the new storage shed at Camp Calvin Crest.
- **3D Season, Calvin Crest Camp Improvements to bridge/course**—Discussion took place about building the pole bridge to walk across in the middle of the course; this would provide us with two course trails. Brad Johannesen will continue to work on this project with the contacts that he has made. He stated that estimates on the poles were \$90-120 per pole. This project is one that the 3D Director Gene Metschke wants to be completed this FALL yet and not be put on the back burner until Spring.

- **501C3 Update**—Chris Johannesen reported that she has completed the 501C3 application for our club to become a non-profit group that can qualify for Grants available to Clubs to promote their sport. She had copies available for the members to review and she asks that the Officers review and give her back any feedback. Next month the application will be considered for approval and if approved, a check for \$750 will be issued to send with the application. *Thanks Chris for all of your hard work!*
- **October dues are due to RHA Club**—President Dave reminded everyone that the RHA Membership dues are due in October! Dues are still \$60.00 per year. A first time joiner needs to pay a \$10.00 key deposit.
